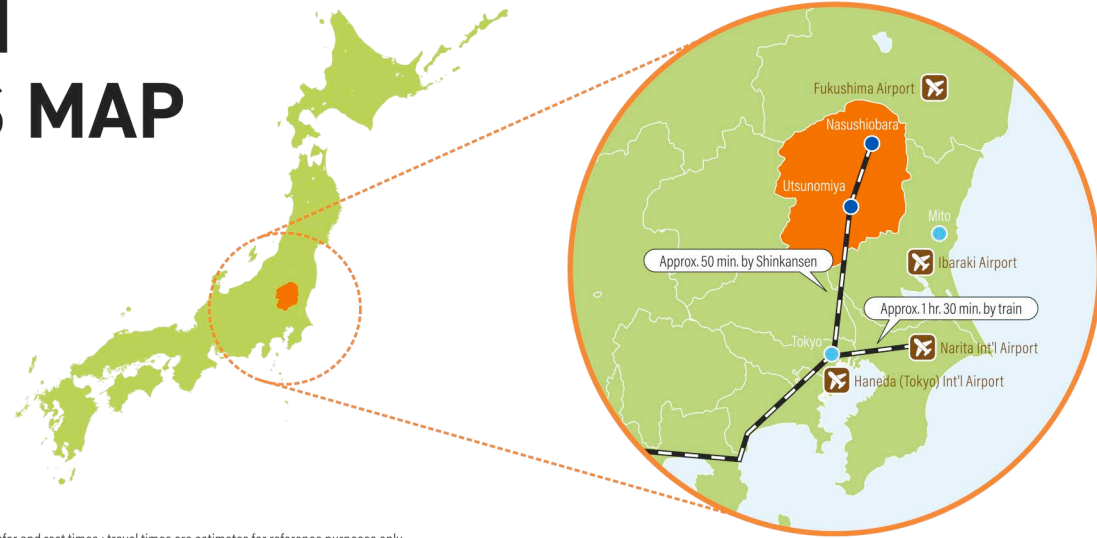


TOCHIGI ACCESS MAP

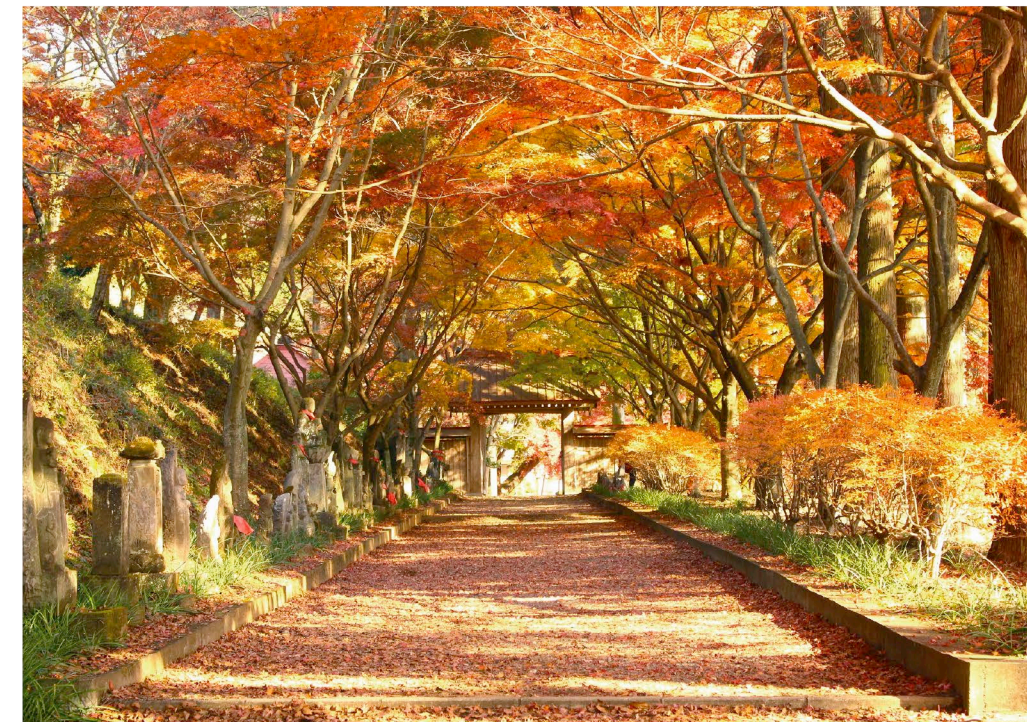
Vivid Colors of Mother Nature

(Best time to visit: Early May to mid-June)



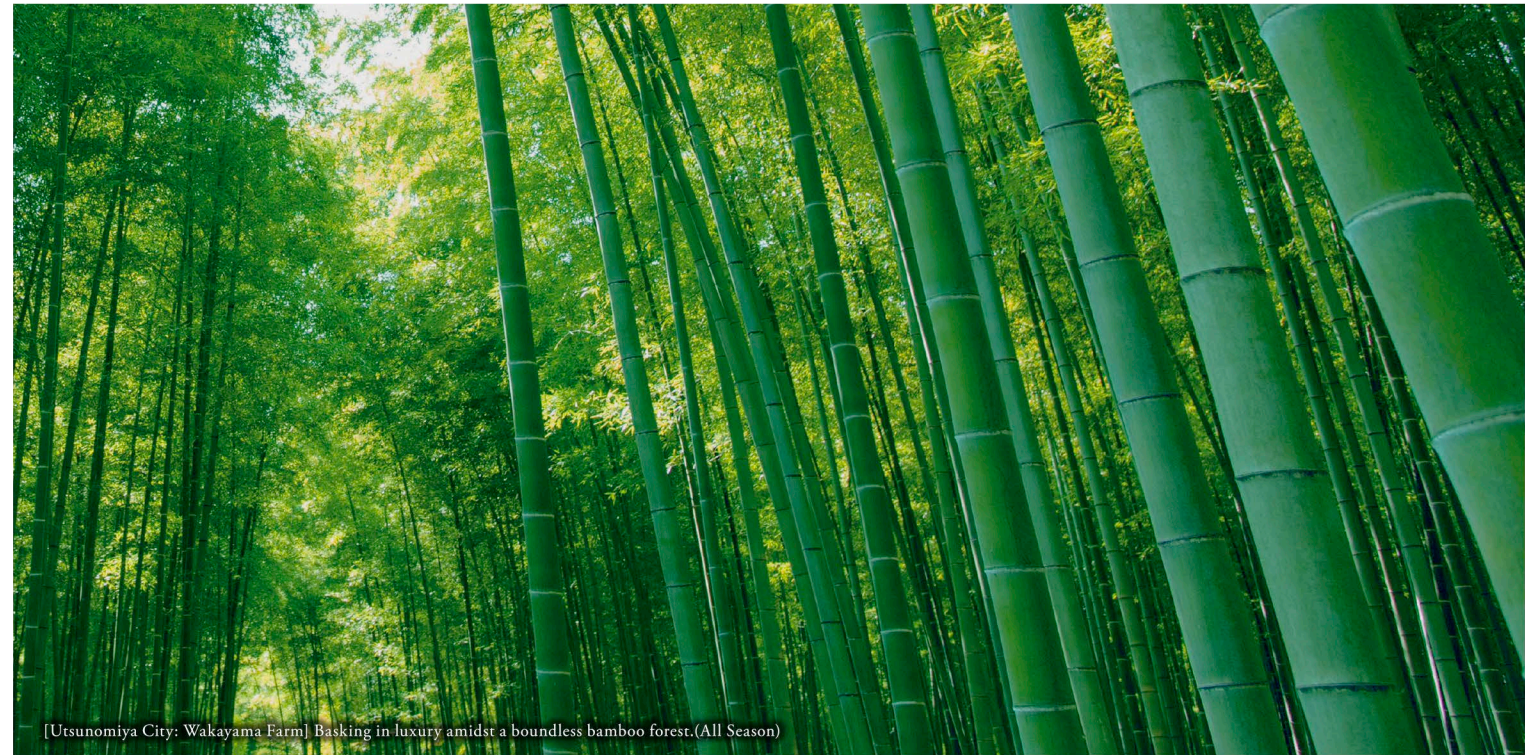
[Otawara City: Kurobane Castle Ruins Park]

[Moka City: Steam Locomotives in Moka] Moka's impressive steam engine speeds through natural splendor. (Best time to visit: Late March to early April)

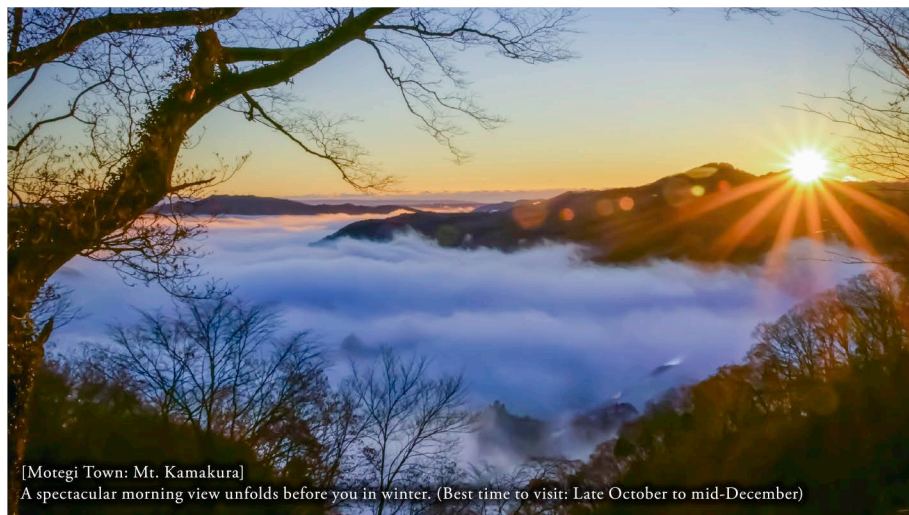


[Utsunomiya City: Wakayama Farm] Basking in luxury amidst a boundless bamboo forest. (All Season)

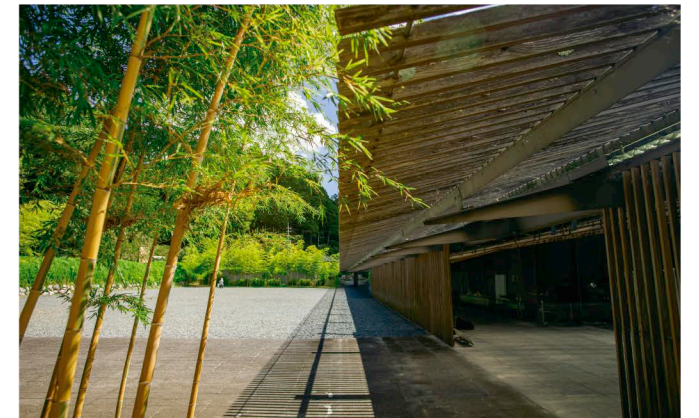

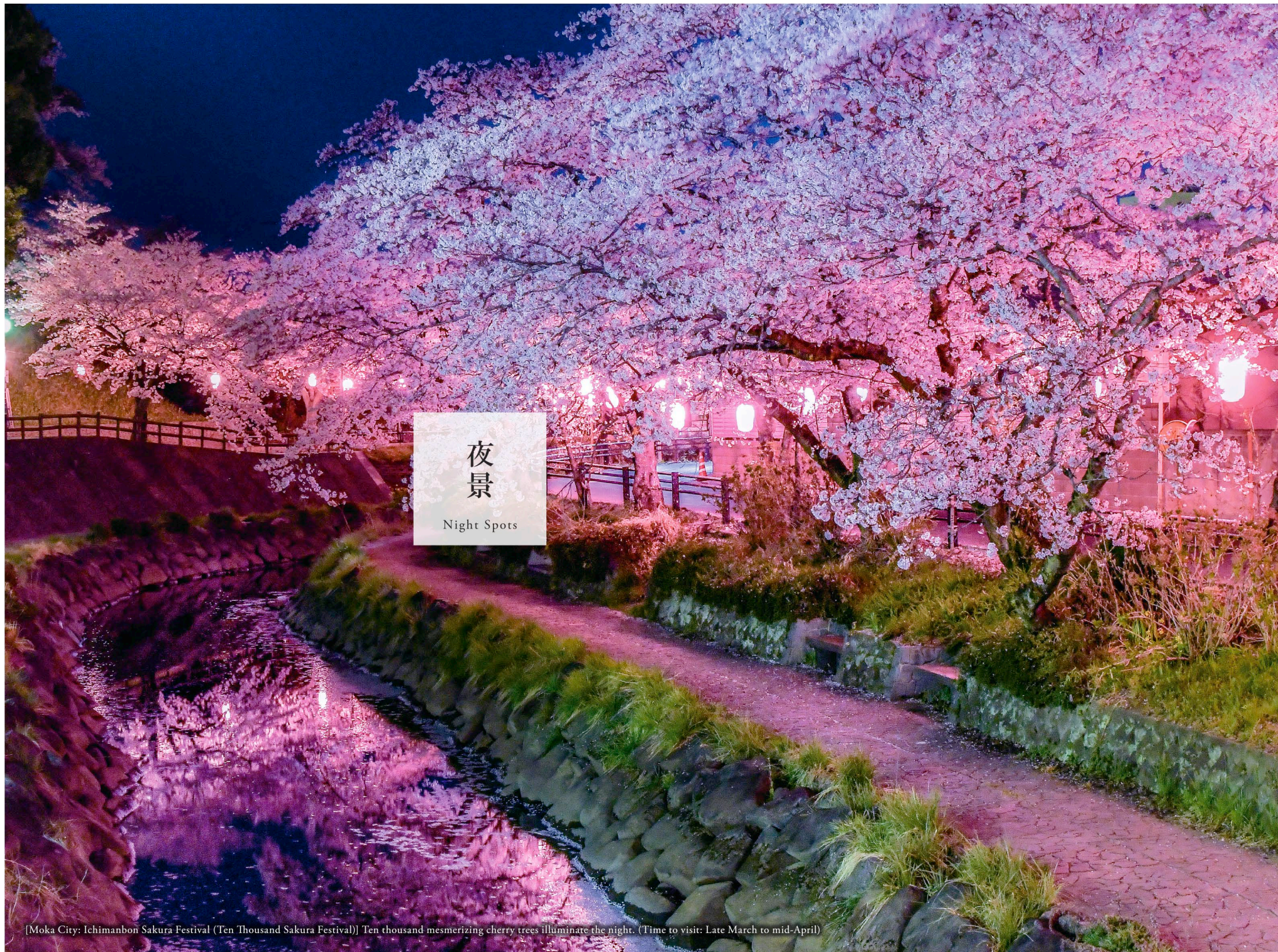

Top Notch Nighttime Spots

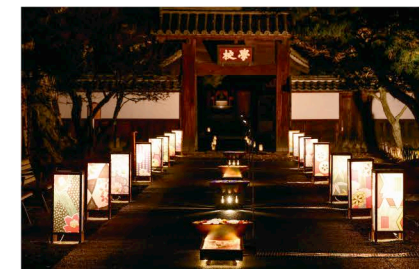
Enter a new reality, impossible to experience in the light of day.

High-grade wagyu beef certified through vigorous inspections.

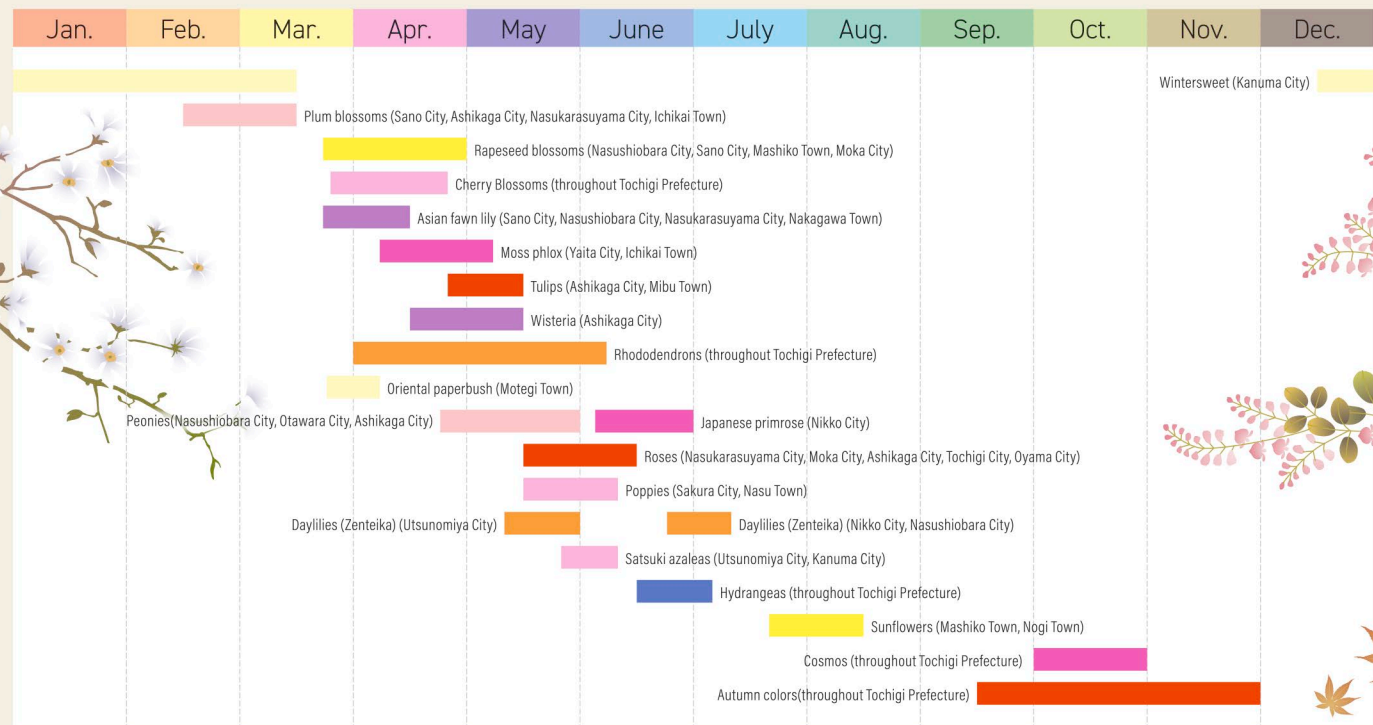

Utsunomiya Gyoza, a popular local food.

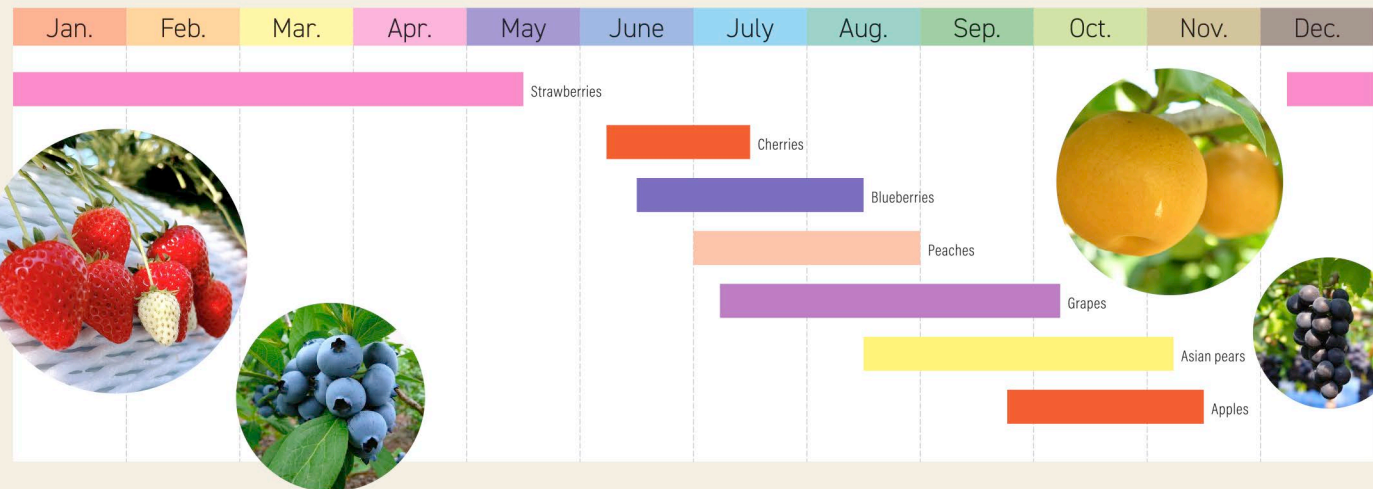


[Sano City : Sano Ramen Noodles]
